



Lutheran Laymen's League Project James

Purpose

To facilitate one-off mission/ministry projects where there is no other source of funding within the LCNZ.

Scope

The scope of projects to be supported are that they are within New Zealand and internal to the LCNZ.

Such projects are not to be considered as a budget-line of the LCNZ or congregations.

Project James may be used to initiate longer-term projects that may be on-going.

Projects may include:

- Training of people and travel related to mission/ministry development
- Purchase of resources for ministry/mission
- Support of mission outreach

Project James may fund up to 100% of the cost of the project. Funding is dependent on funds available.

Who Can Apply

LCNZ auxiliaries, parishes, and congregations can make applications for assistance from the Project James fund. Individuals whose application is endorsed by their congregation or the LCNZ can also make applications.

Reporting

To enable the LLL to evaluate the effectiveness of Project James the LLL expects those receiving funds to provide a report on the funding usage report form, within their agreed time, on the benefits gained through the grant.

Where possible, the LLL would appreciate the inclusion of a quantitative measure of the benefits. For example, amount of usage (resources) or increase in the number of meetings/attendance and/or number and type of follow up activities (missionary development and outreach).
